The teachers will be using phones with the numbers blocked for privacy reasons. When your phone rings at the allotted time be sure to pick up even when you see a blocked number.



The teachers will have prepared for the meetings to ensure as fruitful an exchange as possible. We ask that parents prepare also so that we can share as much information as is needed to benefit the children and inform both the parents and teachers.
